I examined a female basset hound for Bassett Buddies on February 5, 2011 at my personal residence at the request of Teri Drennan who was concerned about the condition of this dog now known as Hope. Ms. Drennan had good reason to be concerned as her condition was poor, please see the attached medical record.

In my professional opinion, Hope received minimal to no medical care while being retained in the Harris County Animal Shelter. I have seen a medical record from their facility that supports my opinion, however, the commissioner's court was informed by Dr. Herminia Palacio that she received daily wound care, antibiotics & pain management (see Fox News Houston investigative reports).

I do believe that someone should be held accountable for the lack of care and compassion shown toward Hope and for lying to the commissioner's court. Feel free to contact me with any further questions.
